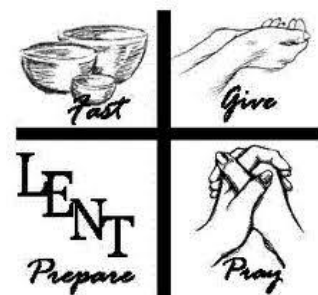

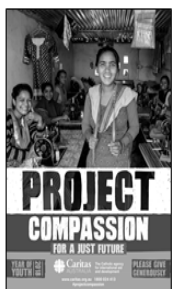
RECEPTION OF SACRAMENTS AT MATER CHRISTI
