PETITION IN RELATION TO ACCESS TO PALLIATIVE CARE

At each of the entrances to the church there is a petition which parishioners are encouraged to read and sign. **There is a great deal of concern that health patients at Joondalup, Midland, Peel, Fremantle and Bentley hospitals have either no or limited access to specialist palliative care thereby restricting information available to make informed choices about their ongoing treatment.** Any queries relating to this petition which is requesting that the Legislative Council support measures to enable patients at these hospitals be given medical advice about their treatment which includes information about palliative care options, may be directed to the LJ Goody Bioethics Centre.
